1. Apologies for absence

Apologies were received from Cllr David Gunton, Cllr Jenna Goodall-Browne due to holiday and Bonnie Wade, these were accepted by the committee.

2. To receive disclosures of interest and dispensations

3. Acceptance of last minutes from the last meeting on Monday 3rd August 2020

4. To discuss any matters arising from the last minutes

5. Discuss the PROW map produced by NCC and decide on questions/comments that are to be sent to Paul Gallop. To also discuss whether any changes are needed in the NP.

It was agreed by all members that any comments/discussions to be had with Norfolk County Council should be a matter for Long Stratton Town Council and not the Neighbourhood Plan committee.

6. To discuss Rachels update to Policy R20 which was e-mailed to all on 5th August 2020.

A discussion was had regarding Policy R20 – Delivering a new community meeting space in Long Stratton, the proposed changes to the policy and the policy intent. It was agreed that the wording in both needed to be changed.

- J.Lawton to request to R.Hogger that the policy intent to be amended to have two separate paragraphs or bullet points. One to say 'the developer will provide the land and build the community meeting space' and the other to say 'or the developer will provide the land and money for the delivery of the community meeting space.'
- The policy is to also be changed to reflect the policy intent.
- J.Lawton to enquire with R.Hogger why the wording 'developer contributions' has been used in the policy. And could the word 'developer contributions collectively' be used instead?
- J.Lawton to also enquire with R.Hogger as to the wording in the policy 'where justified.'

7. To discuss and decide on a date and time for an All Group meeting

It was agreed that any All Group meetings in the future will be held by Long Stratton Town Council and not the Neighbourhood Plan committee.

8. Any other business
